## Types of Scores

Raw-indicates the number of points earned.	Scaled-raw score that has been converted onto a consistent and standardized scale.
Standard-Usually based on a scale that has a statistical mean (average) of 100. Therefore 68% of the population falls between 85-115 and considered <i>normal limits</i> of functioning.	Percentile Rank-percentage of scores that fall below a given score.

<b>Summative</b> -After instruction	<b>Formative</b> -During Instruction
<b>Benchmark</b> -During Instruction	<b>Diagnostic</b> -Prior to instruction
