Sometimes the symptoms of ADHD (such as restlessness, inattention, impulsivity, high activity level, day-dreaming) are often also observed in the gifted student. Little attention has been given to the similarities and differences, thus raising the potential for misidentification in both areas — giftedness and ADHD. DAGEN welcomes one of the premier experts in the country on social and emotional needs of the gifted, **Carolyn Kottmeyer**, as our next speaker to discuss this topic. Carolyn is the founder of the well-known website hoagiesgifted.org, and her facebook group, [hoages gifted education](https://www.facebook.com/hoagesgiftededucation), has 34,000 plus followers. In combination, these two resources are the first stop for many parents and educators on their journey with the gifted or high-ability learner. Carolyn is also on the board at the Social and Emotional Needs of the Gifted, a non-profit organization that seeks to help communities and families meet the needs of gifted and talented individuals. Carolyn herself has experience with raising a child who is gifted and who had been diagnosed with ADHD.
